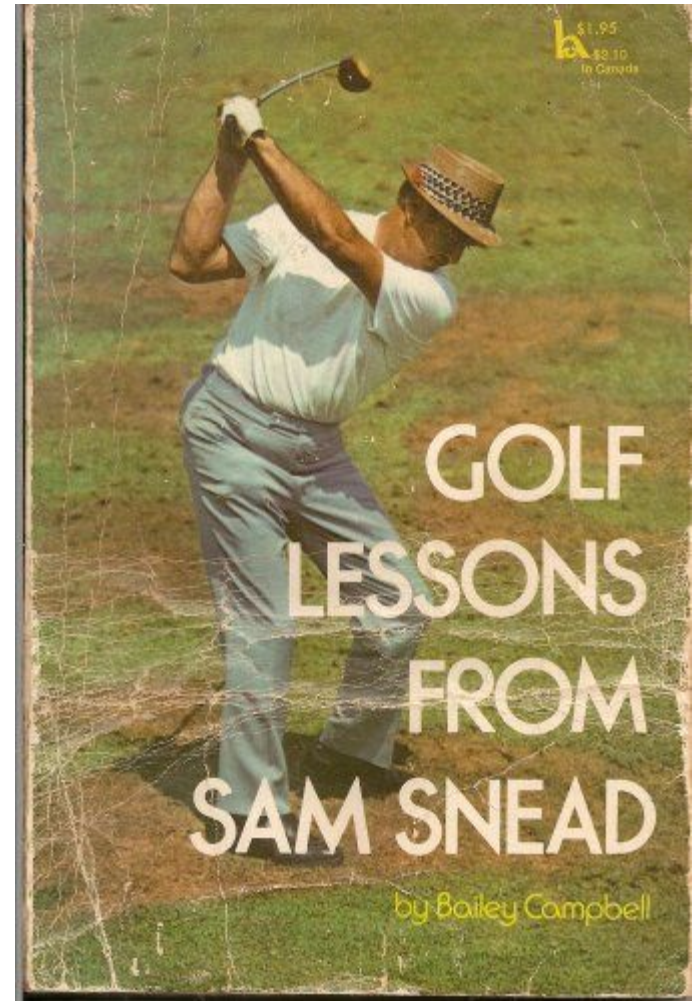

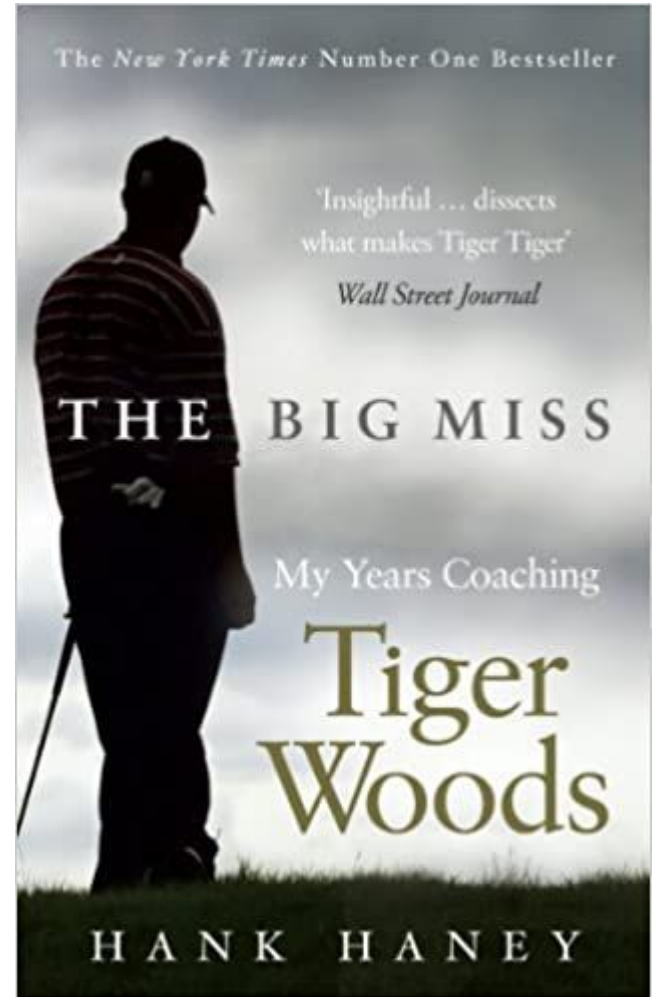
Golf Lessons From Sam Snead

- The lessons on putting and chipping are particularly useful



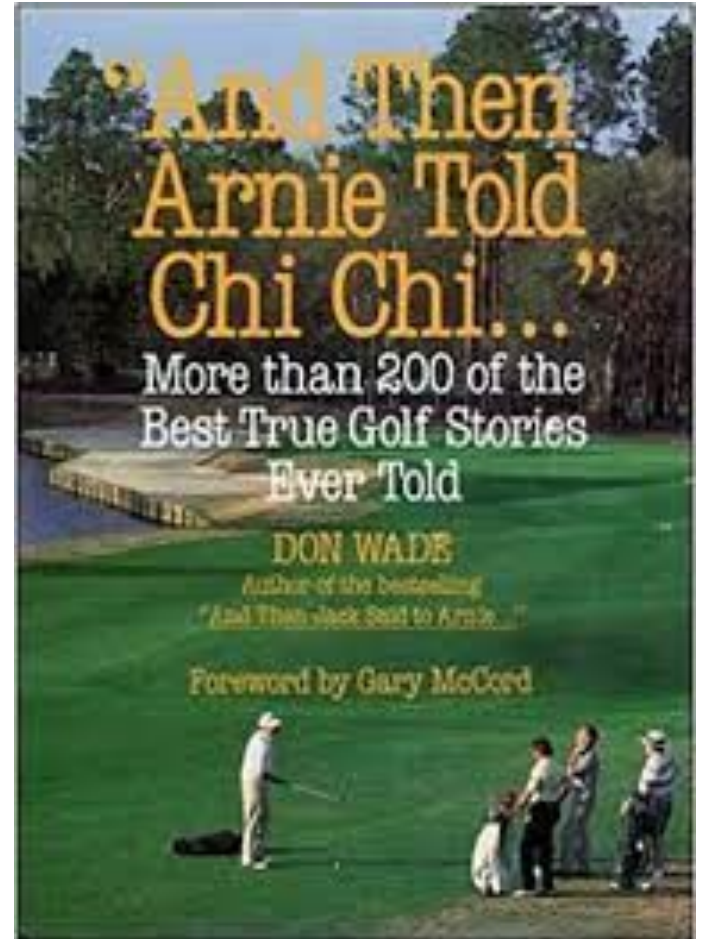
The Big Miss

- Great, easy read - so much humor!



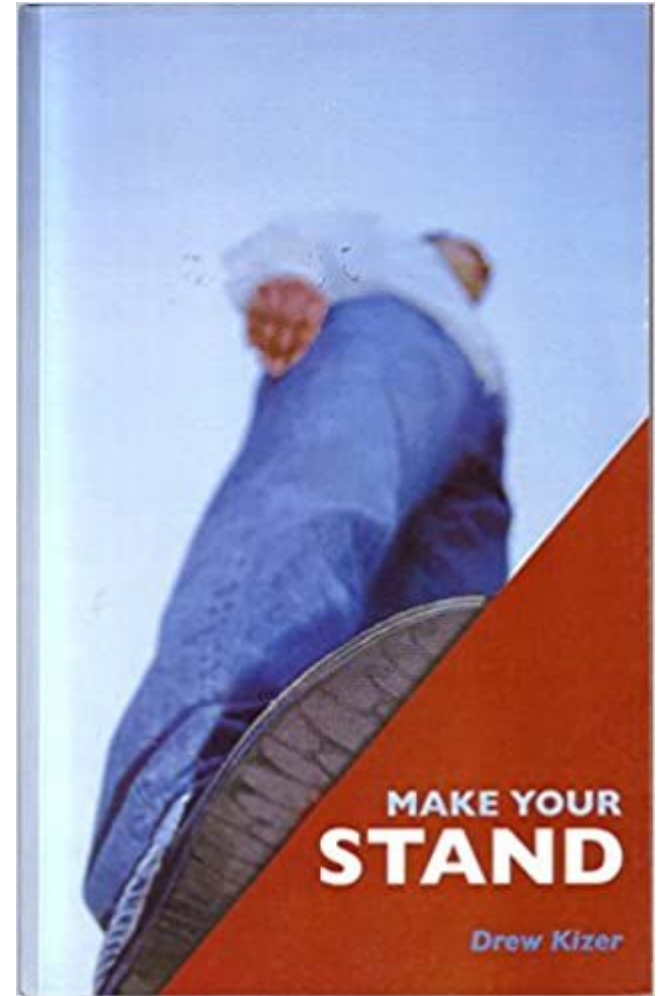
Furia
